

TPHC Show Committee & Executive Committee Meetings
Saturday, December 1, 2018, Beginning at 2:00 p.m.
Los Compadres Restaurant, Lebanon, TN

Tracie Haskell presided over the meeting:

Trail Patterns – anyone offering to make patterns, discussion was given about obstacles available at each facility – Cleveland, Miller, etc. Tracie is to get with each facility to double-check to see what is available. Will invite members to submit a set of patterns for a show and select same at random, once it is verified the obstacles are available and that the patterns meet APHA rules.

Positions needed for shows - ring steward:1 at 2 judge shows and 2 at 4 judge shows, gate person, barn manager; need to be available on Fridays for stabling, shavings, etc. Discussion was given to whether BOD could fill these positions. The positions for the March show are in place. Possibilities for some of the additional shows were MTSU Equestrian and Stock teams as these students have experience in these positions. Each position is a paid position: \$150/day for each position; Tracie reiterated that the March show staff is all taken care of. Need help setting patterns and sped events at each show as well.

Sponsors needed for 2019 – banner hanging, name posted on showbill, etc. ideas accepted; Sheila asked to confirm, \$250/year to get banner posted, question raised about size; banner to be supplied by sponsor

Awards – Belt Buckles ordered for March show already (Molly's Custom Silver), "Sunrise" buckle, ~\$104.70 each; there are to be the following divisions (13):

- Youth WT
- Pilot Youth – halter, wp, horseman, hus, showman, trail, equi (ALL Breed this year); cannot show in Pilot if they show any APHA class
- Youth 13 U
- Youth 18 U
- Novice Youth
- Amateur WT
- Novice Amateur
- Amateur
- Open
- Solid Paint Bred
- All Breed – any age
- Yearling – lungeline, trail, halter, showmanship, color
- 2 YO – lungeline, in hand trail, halter, showmanship, color, after 7/1 2 yo hus, wp; discussion given to whether or not to count in hand as Non APHA or ALL Breed; All Breed halter, showmanship in hand trail ? is whether or not to single out 2 yo inhand trail and count points as if it is an APHA class or leave it as an All breed class; decision is to leave as NON APHA class; Decision: 2 & U All breed

Consignment Sale – Sheila \$10 to consign, 10% commission decided – money to go to general funds, but earmarked to go towards awards; drop off on Friday morning

Mentor “packet”/Ambassador Program- info about club officers, BOD, manager, secretary, etc. job descriptions, show etiquette, etc. general information about some classes, rules and guidelines, ambassadors for show; officer BOD + youth (4 people per day) to be available; small banner at stall to identify

Contender Series - New APHA Program approved, similar to Pilot Program, has to be on a paint and an APHA member, but not have to be owner “Contender Series” for youth and adults, do earn points; voluntary program; not sure yet if it is 2019 or 2020; at this point we will keep the Pilot program. Pending more details from APHA.

High Points – 2015 yearling and 2 yo got changed in August; it was changed that horse had to only be shown in 1 show to be eligible for class high point. Current rules for all other classes are that the class must be shown 4 times to be eligible for class high point awards. For overall division awards as long as the horse showed 1 class in the division at least 3 shows then all points in that division were counted towards the overall high point division award. This effects exhibitors that perhaps come to every show but the one who comes to just the largest show gets the award; other divisions have to come to 4 shows Decision made that the rules for 2019 stay the same except for the yearlings and 2 year olds for class award must show at at least 3 shows to be eligible

Agreed to for show high point/circuit must show halter and color class unless solid bred, all bred or Pilot division.

For May and July Shows we will have 1 circuit award that encompasses both show dates vs Show high point awards for each day.

ShowBill:

- All Breed – Halter, Showmanship, HUS, Eq, WP, Horsemanship, Trail, Ranch Riding, 2 yo & under in hand trai and lungeline.l
- NSBA approval for March show, \$75 approval fee, amount for entry per class to go to NSBA, club also keeps a portion
- Pilot added halter this year
- Regular Classes

- Solid Paint Bred – keep offering? Can do individual classes as combined (trail, showmanship, etc.); going to be the same as it has been
- Discussion on when to hold Color Classes; maybe require people to enter color to be considered for high point
- Green – Open High Point, will it count? It has been with the open division – still counts as class high point, but not to count for show high point or year-end; still get a year-end award

Suggested to bring new people in: If member brings new person to a show, get a stall and new exhibitor – discussion was given to this idea although the group consensus was to not provide this incentive at this time as it is felt that some of the changes already implemented will bring in additional horses.

March – hospitality, food for Friday or Saturday night? Discussion was given to different options, no decisions made. Additional discussion about food, i.e. the chili cookout were mentioned. Harriman will not allow “outside” food per the contract; several options were discussed about other options, no final decision made. It was mentioned that Stacey Lee, “The Lunch Lady” be contacted to see if available for all shows other than Harriman. Will offer at both 4 judge shows a hus and wp jackpot class to be first class for those classes \$50 entry fee will pay 3 places must have 5 entries to have the class.

Discussed rather or not to add a 1 day 2 judge show on our Oct. date at Lebanon. Opted against but will look at doing a 2 day clinic with nationally recognized clinician one for showmanship one for trail (Charlene carter/Tommy Sheets) limited number pf exhibitors but then charge audit fee for spectators in place of our October show. Arlene will look into and present back to group.

Club bought a Defibrillator (\$1500.00) but it never came to us when the club split. Tracie to get with Jennifer and/or Kathy about same.
