

TPHC/TjPHC Year End Award Rules

Owner and Exhibitor must be a member of TPHC/TjPHC prior to points being earned.

For 2019 We have 6 shows (May and July count as a separate show each day)

Yearlings/Two Year Olds for class high point must show the class at 3 shows.

All Other Class High Points: Class must be shown at 4 shows

Division Year End Overall High Point Champion and Reserve Champion will be awarded in the following divisions: Youth Walk/Trot, Pilot Youth, Novice Youth, Youth 13 and Under, Youth 18 and Under, Amateur Walk/Trot, Novice Amateur, Amateur, Open, Solid Paint Bred and All Breed.

To qualify for Overall High Point Awards the horse/exhibitor must show in that division at 3 shows. Open division requires only the horse be shown at 3 shows (can have a different rider as the points go to the horse/owner) . All points earned for the division will count as long as the horse was shown in that division at 3 shows.

In the event that a horse is injured or dies an exhibitor may make a one- time change to another horse . ie; Smokey is injured and out for the remainder of the season. The exhibitor starts showing Mickey for the remained of the year. Both horses' points will count for the year end award. However, if the exhibitor returns to showing Smokey; only Smokey's point will be considered. An exhibitor cannot substitute multiple horses after the injury or death of their main horse.
