

2020 TPHC/TjPHC Year End Award Rules

Owner and Exhibitor must be a member of TPHC/TjPHC prior to points being earned. For 2020 we have seven (7) shows. July and August count as a separate show each day.

YEAR END CLASS High Point Awards Requirements:

Yearlings and Two Year Old horses must be shown at a minimum of 4 shows.

All other horses must be shown at a minimum of 5 shows.

YEAR END DIVISION Champion and Reserve Champion Requirements:

Yearlings must show at a minimum of 4 shows and ONLY APHA yearling classes will count toward this award. Only point earning classes with 2 or more entries will count toward Champion and Reserve Champion.

Two Year Olds must show at a minimum of 4 shows and ONLY APHA two year old classes will count toward this award. Only point earning classes with 2 or more entries will count toward Champion and Reserve Champion.

Halter Mare, Halter Gelding and Halter Stallion must show at a minimum of 5 shows. There must be a minimum of 5 horses shown in open and amateur combined to count toward Champion and Reserve Champion.

To qualify for the remaining divisions the horse/exhibitor must show in that division at 4 shows. The horse must be shown in a minimum of three (3) performance classes and a halter class. Open division requires only that the horse be shown at 4 shows but can have different exhibitors as the points go to the horse/owner. All points earned for the division will count as long as the horse meets this requirement. Color classes and green classes do not count toward overall high points.

In the event a horse is injured or dies, an exhibitor may make a one time change to another horse. Example: Smokey is injured and out indefinitely. Exhibitor starts showing Mickey. Both horses points will count for year end awards. However, if the exhibitor returns to showing Smokey, only Smokey's points will be counted. An exhibitor cannot substitute multiple horses after the injury or death of their first horse.
